Prohibited Items

- Live or dead animals
- Drugs
- Illegal narcotic substances
- Firearms (including parts) and Ammunition
- Fake/dummy/game/toy weapons or replicas, paint ball guns , BB guns, antique weapons, swords, knives, fake grenades etc
- Items that could be used as weapons (These include but are not limited to decorative swords, kitchen knives etc), weapon parts
- Human remains (including ashes)
- Furs and skins (untreated)
- Indecent goods and clothes, sex toys & pornographic materials
- Any noxious substance
- Plants
- Foodstuff
- Perishable goods
- Tobacco
- E-cigarettes
- Packages that are wet, leaking or emit any odor of any kind
- Liquid Material including but not limited to Shampoo, body lotion ... etc

Valuable Items

- Bullion
- Cash or currency
- Fake/Dummy/Collectable cash, currency and stamps
- Payment cards, traveler cheques, Passports, IDs..etc
- Jewelry
- Precious metals & stones
- Works of Art
- Antiques
- Items of a fragile nature

Dangerous Goods

All items, irrespective of packaging, listed in the IATA Dangerous Goods Regulations are not to be sent by courier. These include:
