Mr. Aljeda was appointed as Chief Executive Officer for Aramex in Europe, North America and Asia in July 2017. Based in London, he is responsible for leading the successful development and execution of Aramex's long-term business strategy in these regions.

In addition to his current role, Aljeda has been serving as the CEO for Aramex in Asia since 2007. He was responsible for setting up the regional office and develop Aramex's expansion programs across Asia, and currently responsible for all day-to-day management decisions and the implementation of Aramex's long- and short-term plans in that region.

Mr. Aljeda joined Aramex in 1994 as a management trainee, and after completing the program, he was appointed as the General Manager of Aramex in Qatar. He was then promoted to General Manager of Aramex in Saudi Arabia, where he led the company's entry into the Saudi Market, and later became the Vice President of Aramex in Saudi Arabia, Upper Gulf, South Asia and the Far East. He was then relocated to Singapore as Aramex CEO in Asia. He is currently based in the UK.

He is an active member of the company's Global Management Team and sits on several boards related to logistics and transportation in South Asia and Asia-Pacific. He is also active with several universities that participate in programs for MBA students in the field of Logistics.

He holds a BA from Richmond University, United Kingdom and has completed a number of executive development and management programs namely from the Business School of Wharton University in Pennsylvania, USA.

In May 2020, Mr. Aljeda assumed the role of Aramex's Acting Chief Operating Officer (COO) replacing Iyad Kamal, until a permanent successor is named.
